Cornerstones of Care also offers its employees development opportunities through leadership training program, computer software classes, and an inter-agency transfer policy that allows employees to move to another agency while retaining tenure and benefits.

Job Description

We are interviewing for Registered Nurses responsible for the coordination of physical and mental healthcare services to children in foster care. This includes the tracking of healthcare related appointments and providing consultation to Family Support Teams around medical issues, where expertise is needed. This is not a direct care position.

Specific Duties

1. Develop a Child Health Summary, based on an assessment of each child's health, nutritional status, and psycho/social status. The Child Health Summary shall be a plan for the child's health care services.
 1. Coordinate and assist in the delivery of a plan of health care as developed for the children in out-of-home care from Jackson County.
 2. Monitor a child's prescribed medications.
 3. Ensure all contract outcomes are attained for children on assigned caseload, and partner with other Nurse Case Management staff to assist in the entire program meeting contract outcomes.
 4. Participate in the weekly on-call rotation in order to provide after hours medical consultation for Foster Care Case Managers across Jackson County.
 6. Provide training/consultation on around medical issues to families, out-of-home providers, and other FST members as needed for: concerning medication usage, medical procedure clarification, the general needs of children in out-of-home care, etc.
 7. Interpret medical findings, and be able to communicate them to nonmedical individuals.
 8. Coordinate multiple community and state agency services to the medical benefit of the child.
 9. Evaluate progress in accessing appropriate behavioral and physical health medical care and other needed services.
 10. Work effectively as part of the Nurse Case Management team, each child's family support team, and with other child welfare partners.
 11. Effectively maintain a caseload of approximately 100 children.
