Many of those served by Cornerstones of Care have experienced significant trauma or adversity, which can potentially lead to poor mental or physical health, unemployment and poverty, incarceration, or repeating cycles of abuse or neglect.

"Our collective years of experience have shown us the unfortunate, long-term consequences when services like ours are not available," says Terry Putney of Transition Advisors, LLC and the Cornerstones of Care Board Chair. "We want every child and family to have the opportunity to be successful, whether it's a child in the classroom, a first-time parent, or a young adult transitioning out of foster care. Coming together strengthens our current services while also allowing us to focus efforts on meeting the growing needs we know are there."

Through its many treatment, education and support services, Cornerstones of Care helps these children and families improve their mental, physical and behavioral health, and build towards a safe and healthy future. Cornerstones of Care supports safe and healthy communities through its critical prevention services. These services, ranging from weekly relationship classes to in-home intensive supports, partner with children and families to improve skills and access resources that help build a safe and healthy family unit.

As one organization, Cornerstones of Care will create new, innovative solutions that meet the evolving health needs of our communities. Cornerstones of Care understands that health is more than physical or mental well-being, and together, their team of 900+ will provide children and families seamless access to its full range of 36 programs and services. With a vision to improve whole-person health in our communities, Cornerstones of Care will leverage decades of expertise to build bridges that connect children and families to the resources they need to grow and thrive.

Missy Creed, a Cornerstones of Care treatment foster care and adoptive parent, cites the "whole team" working together to meet needs of both foster children and foster parents. A year and a half into placement of three children, one child was admitted to residential treatment on the Spofford Campus. "Due to whole team support, the placement stayed intact and she was able to stay with her sisters," says Missy. Now, all children in care of the Creed family receive outpatient services from Cornerstones of Care.
